

Key Stage 2 SAT results 2017

The table below highlights our Year 6 SATS. The format for assessing pupils at the end of KS 2 changed from 2017. A scaled score of 100 or greater was the expected standard and a score of 110 or greater demonstrated that they had achieved a 'greater depth of the standard'. Progress was calculated using the children's Average Point Scales overall in Reading, Writing and Maths from KS 1.
