## PE and Sports Premium Funding Action Plan 2017 – 2018

### What is PE and Sports Premium Funding?

The PE and Sport Premium Funding is a Government grant that is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of PE and sport activities they offer to their pupils. The premium must be spent by schools on making additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles for all pupils.

### How much did Pirton School receive?

For the academic year 2017 - 2018, Pirton School was allocated £17,200. Together with a carry forward of £1,770 this gives a total for the year of **£18,970**

Key Actions	Approximate Cost	Desired Impact
Purchase of Outdoor Gym Equipment	£10,000	Children have access to a range of purpose built outdoor gym equipment to develop skills in co-ordination, balance, agility and build overall fitness.
Membership of North Herts School Sports Partnership (NHSSP)	£840	Inclusion in local sporting events.  Continued professional development to ensure sustainability of PE provision.
Maths of the Day subscription	£500	Children will be active and practising physical skills as part of the daily Maths lessons. This also allows for a firm cross curricular link to become embedded across the school.
Transport and associated costs for participation in local sporting events.	£1,200	Enable all pupils to take part in inter-school sporting fixtures including Rural Sports fixtures across the year.
Subscription to Stevenage Borough Football Club's Football Foundation	£600	All classes will have access to a qualified coach who will deliver a 5 week programme of sports and curriculum links e.g. Leaderships skills (PSHE) and Active Maths. Coaches will also run lunchtime and after school clubs, focusing upon Fitness Fun and a range of alternative sports at lunchtime e.g. Netball, Hockey, Athletics.
PE equipment: focus upon EYFS and KS1 equipment. Schemes of work/music CDs for dance. Equipment for lunchtime play/play leaders.	£2,000	Good quality resources available to support the teaching and learning of PE across the school.
Increase range of physical activities children experience through themed days/taster sessions	£730	Encourage all children to engage with sport. To inspire and motivate children. To develop a healthy lifestyle.
Professional development for teachers and PE Subject Leader.	£1,600	Staff to be trained and upskilled ensuring high quality PE provision for children.
Playground markings	£1,500	Children have access to a range of playground markings which allow them to be active during playtimes and lunchtimes and during lesson times e.g 100 square, phonic wheel.
