

## Class 1 Curriculum Plan Summer Term 2016

### Summer Term 1

This half term our topic is 'Castles.' Our continuous provision will be topic based and we will be providing a 'Castle' in the role play area, with musical instruments and material to encourage imaginative play. In the book corner there will be fiction (Traditional Tales) and non-fiction books based around castles. We are learning about Materials in Science and in the Investigation Area, there will be materials for the children to explore and challenge cards to encourage them to take the materials and test them to find out more about their properties, e.g. if they are waterproof. In English we will be looking at Traditional Stories, letters and postcards, nonsense poems, stories about families, information texts and action poems. In Maths we will be learning about number, place value, fractions, addition, subtraction, measures, data, multiplication, division (Year 1), shape and money. In Art we will be making the most of the outdoor classroom and using Natural Materials to create pieces based on the work of Andy Goldsworthy. In Geography we will be looking at maps and their particular characteristics as well as using compass directions. There will be a cross curricular link with Computing as we will be using the Bee Bots to find the treasure on a pirate map! In RE we will be learning about Relationships. In PE we will be swimming this half term.

### Summer Term 2

During Term 2 our topic will be 'Beaches'. In Maths we will be using numbers, shape and time linked with our topic. In English we will be looking at stories and non-fiction books based around the seaside. In History we will be looking at seaside towns from the past and in Geography we will be looking at seaside towns, capital cities and holiday destinations. We will be using our topic to support our play based learning in Reception.
