

## Class 1 Summer Term

Mrs Perry will be teaching Class One on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

Mrs Herbaut will be teaching on a Thursday and Friday.

In Class One, for the first half of the summer term our topic is going to be 'A Carnival of Animals'. Within this topic we will be looking at the different places that animals live in the world, focussing on the differences between animals that live in hot and cold climates. After half term it will be about toys. Within this topic we will be looking at our favourite toys, old and new toys and thinking about changes in living memory.

Our R.E will be about relationships, special people and animals. We will read stories from different cultures and religions.

In Music we will sing songs about animals, such as the animal fair, listen to the carnival of the animals and add accompaniments to the story 'We're going a bear hunt'. We will also compose our own music and rhythm for an animal/ toy parade and create our own high and low sounds using body and percussion instruments.

We will be looking at different species of animals and how we can group and classify them. We will be looking closely at their patterns and camouflage and creating art using what we observe.

For the first part of the summer term we will be going swimming and then we will be developing our athletic skills and preparing for sports day.

The second half of the summer term is about toys. We will be exploring how toys work, comparing toys from the past and making toys in DT.

Our Numeracy will be focussed on basic skills, number bonds to 10 and 20 and securing number facts. We will be practising telling the time, sorting 2-D and 3-D shapes, measuring length and weight of objects and investigating capacity.

We will also take part in a theatre workshop 'A Carnival of Animals' and we hope to organise a trip to a wild life park!

Throughout the term we hope to spend as much of our time outside and we will be working on our allotment space.
