

Class 3 Summer Term 2016

For the first part of the summer term, our topic will be Pirton and Beyond. We will be comparing Pirton to the surrounding villages and towns and learning about the history of the village. This will link to our Design and Technology project, in which we will be sewing symbols that are important to Pirton.

After half term, we will be moving on to the topic of Sunflowers in which we will be researching about the life and works of Vincent Van Gogh, sketching our own flowers and finding patterns within these.

In Science, we will be investigating and identifying different rocks and fossils, including their formation. Then we will recognise the need for light, understand different light sources and investigate shadows.

In Computing the children will begin to understand the difference between data and information. They will enter, organise and search data, deriving information which they will learn to present in different forms.
