

Class 3 Curriculum Overview Summer 2017

Over the next term, our Topic will be Lighthouses. The children will learn about the purpose and essential positioning of lighthouses and the geographical features and potential dangers of the United Kingdom's coastal areas. We will also be investigating the historical figure of Grace Darling, the impact she had on saving lives and the importance of being an influential heroine.

We will link this topic with our Design Technology project, in which we will be designing and making our own working lighthouses, including understanding and building electrical circuits.

In Art, the children will be exploring with light and dark materials, using different drawing techniques, to create their own seascapes. Then in Music, we will be exploring compositions related to the Human Body and French.

Our Science topic for the first half of the term is Animals including Humans, where we are going to be investigating being healthy through understanding the basic needs for survival and also, understanding the need for muscles and skeletons. For the second part of the term, we will be learning about Light by creating our own investigations into the forming and patterns of shadows, the position of the sun and the importance of keeping our eyes safe around light.

Furthermore in our Computing lessons, children will investigate the differences between data and information and how to research and enter their own information into databases.

Lastly, Mrs Banks will still teach the children Religious Education, where the children will be learning about key religious leaders and religious questions. Similarly, the children will continue to have Rising Stars on a Monday morning, but will need their clean P.E. kit in school for the entire week.
