

Class 4 Summer Term 2017

Our topic for the Summer Term will be 'The Dark Ages'. This topic will be mostly history based, exploring Anglo-Saxon life and their relationships with Scots and Viking invasions.

Literacy will involve consolidating the grammar and punctuation rules we have learnt so far, whilst improving the style and accuracy of our writing. Literacy topics will include: 'A history of clothes', 'Goodnight Mr Tom' and 'Foxes'.

In maths, we will be revisiting some topics and introducing others in the areas of; Roman numerals, scale, percentages, fractions, decimals, angles and data.

In Science our topic is 'The life cycles of animals and plants.' During this topic we will visit Whipsnade Zoo to take part in a 'Minibeasts Investigate' session.

In art we will be using drawing, painting and sculpting techniques to create representations of plants including flowers and fruits.

In RE, we will mostly be looking at leaders in Religious Communities. In P.E. We will develop our throwing, catching and striking through games such as cricket and rounders. In PSHE, we will be covering the topic 'relationships'. French will involve learning new vocabulary and developing our speaking and listening skills in the language. We will learn how important accuracy is when using computers, through creating flowcharts for mechanical devices. Finally, in music, we will be focussing on our understanding composition, beat, notation and performance.
