

## English

- **Fiction-** Through looking at the work of Beatrix Potter, the children will develop their narrative and descriptive skills. Children will also read and work on books by Anthony Browne that deal with feelings and childhood fears.
- **Non-fiction-** Children will learn how to format and independently write a letter and postcard, understand why people write to each other and be able to write statements, questions and exclamations
- **Poetry-** Using A Great Big Cuddle by Michael Rosen, young children enjoy poetry specifically written for them. Children also will enjoy nonsense poetry and the zany humour of Oi Frog and use it as a model for rhymes about animals and chairs.

Our class reading book is We all went on Safari by Laurie Krebs and Julia Cains.

## PSHE

The Seal topics we will be looking at this term are relationships and changes including how we manage our feelings.

## R.E

Through the topic of relationships, we will be looking at special people and places.

## Music

We are looking at timbre and structure through the topics of our senses and stories and sounds.

**P.E** Rising Stars () – Every Monday. Wednesday is swimming for the first half of the term and Tuesdays for in the second half of the term.

## Mathematics

- **Number and place value-** reciting, ordering and comparing numbers to 100. Count on in tens from single-digit numbers and back and working out halves and quarters of shapes and amounts.
- **Addition and subtraction-** add and subtract single-digit numbers to and from 2-digit numbers using facts. Find totals of money amounts. Know the best order to add amounts. Work out change by finding the difference.
- **Measures and shape-** order days of the week and months of the year. Tell the time to the nearest half hour and find times half an hour later. Recognise 3D shapes and discuss how they have been turned. Understand and compare capacity.
- **Multiplication and division-** Double, halve, and multiply. Understand multiplication as repeated addition. Work out simple division problems by finding how many sets in a given number.

## History

We will be looking at seaside towns in the past and how they have changed.

## Geography

We will be looking at UK geography through our seaside topic, learning about countries in the UK and their capital cities and seaside towns

## Science
