

Class 3 Curriculum Overview

Autumn Term 2016

Over the next term, our topic will be the Stone Age. The children will learn about the similarities and differences between people living prehistorically and ourselves. The children will also have an exciting opportunity to go to Celtic Harmony Camp to take part in a Stone Age day, in which they will take on the roles of hunters and gatherers. They will also get to explore the tools that were used as part of the Stone Age lifestyle!

We will link this historical topic with our Design Technology project, in which we will be learning about seasonal foods and the children will create and eat their own seasonal salad. In Art, the children will be making their own paint, in order to create their own Stone Age cave paintings. Then in Music, we will be exploring sounds and duration.

Also in our Geography lessons, the children will be able to explore maps and keys and the continents and oceans of the world.

Our Science topic for the first half term is Plants, where we are going to be investigating the different roles each part of a plant has and the lifecycle of a plant. For the second part of the term, we will be learning about Living Things and their Habitats to develop our understanding of the requirements of living things, through their choice of home and food chains.

In our Computing lessons, children will be developing their understanding of communication and how to stay safe when using technology. They will also be taught by Mrs Banks for Religious Education.

The children will have Rising Stars on a Monday morning, but they will need their P.E. kit in school for the entire week.
