

Class 5 Curriculum Letter

Spring Term 2017

Our topic this term is Crime and Punishment Through the Ages. The children will learn about what acts were considered a crime in different periods of time and learn about the different (and sometimes gruesome) punishments which existed. Our trip to the Tower of London will be a great starting point to understanding the consequences for some crimes in Britain's past.

We will focus upon Materials and their Properties in Science this term, investigating what makes changes reversible and irreversible and considering changes of state of materials. Computing lessons will focus upon the use of spreadsheets as 'Information Models'. Children will have two PE sessions each week with games continuing to be taught by a Rising Stars Coach and hockey on a Thursday afternoon. Our music lessons will be linked to performance and composition.

In the latter part of the term, children will learn about Cityscapes in Art and the construction of Bridges in D.T. In RE, lessons will consider the Expressions of Faith through Music, Drama and Art. PSHE will focus upon 'The World of Work' and children will learn that certain skills can be used for different tasks and know the range of knowledge, skills and personal qualities required for different types of work. This also links with our whole school SEAL (Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning) topic of Going for Goals and Good to be Me.
