- Persuasive Language

In this unit of work, pupils will deconstruct some speeches from some villainous fictional characters to discover the secret to writing persuasively.

- Modern classic Fiction

Our class reader will be Kensuke's Kingdom; a modern classic that will inspire students to write in a variety of fiction and non-fiction genres.

- Poet Study

We will study the life and works of nineteenth-century American poet Emily Dickinson and create poetry inspired by her work.

Science – Animals Including Humans

After completing our current focus on Evolution and Inheritance, we will study the topic of Animals Including Humans.

Pupils will learn:

- How scientific ideas about food and diet were tested in the past and how this has contributed to our knowledge of a balanced diet
- Investigate some different food groups and find out why having a variety of foods is important for a healthy diet
- Investigate how nutrients and water are transported around the body
- Investigate what happens to the heart when we exercise
- Learn how muscles move the skeleton.

The United Kingdom

Geography – The United Kingdom

In this topic, pupils will learn to describe key geographical features of the United Kingdom as well as identify and locate counties, cities and towns. We will learn about the major hills and mountains, rivers, seas and coasts. We will refine our map-reading and grid referencing skills as well as using digital resources.
