We have recently disposed of three bin liners of unclaimed and unnamed lost property. Only ten items out of many more were able to be returned to their owners because they were named.

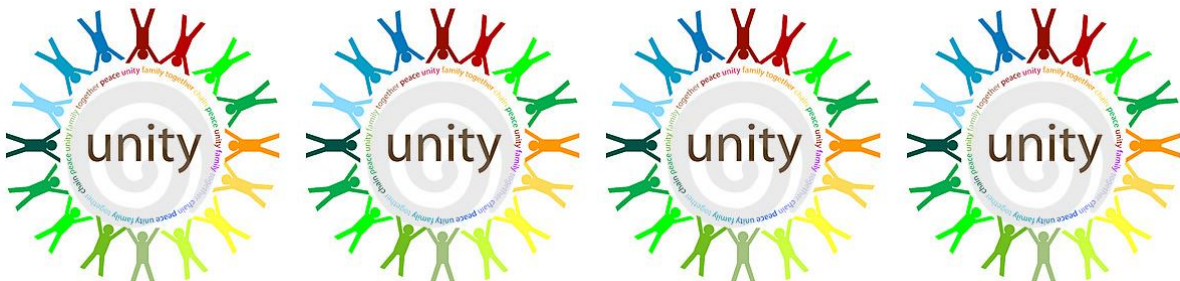
Please make sure uniform and personal items are clearly labelled or named so that they can be easily identified. Marker pens fade with washing so please check every now and then to make sure labels are still visible.

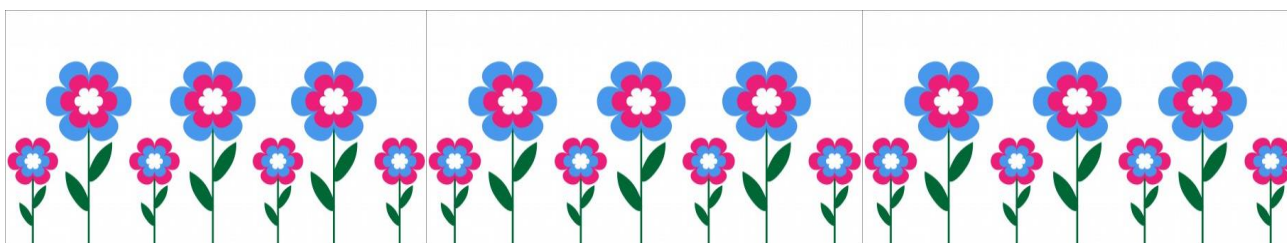
Summer Fair – Programme Cover Design competition
