We ended our week of activities with a commemorative Assembly this morning. Our poppies were on display – see photo below. The village Act of Remembrance will take place at the War Memorial in Crabtree Lane on Sunday morning and Mrs Fenner will be laying a wreath on behalf of the school.

#### **World War I Trenches Recipe**

During our WWI workshops this week, the children enjoyed tasting a biscuit based on a recipe from the trenches. Thanks go to our Cook, Mrs Pearce, for making the biscuits for us. The children seem keen to try out the recipe at home so here are the instructions! Thanks to Mrs Fryer for supplying us with the recipe.

#### MILK & BISCUIT PUD - WW1 Trench Adapted Recipe.

Serves 6-8

7oz digestive biscuits

4oz mixed dried fruit and peel

2 x 370g tins condensed milk (plain milk not the new caramel)

You need a 3 pint ungreased baking dish with at least one inch of space around the top. The initial liquid mix will rise during baking and literally needs room to rise.

Crush biscuits finely.

Combine with fruit and peel in baking dish.

Pour the condensed milk over it and stir thoroughly.

Leave to soak for 3 hours.



Bake in preheated oven at 150 degrees for one and a quarter hours or until it is browned on top and looks like a Christmas cake (!).
