Science

We will look at the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
Identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals including animals native to Australia and say whether they are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets)

Design Technology

Through making healthy smoothies we will be looking at healthy eating and understanding where food comes from as well as focusing on using tools safely.
We will be looking at Australian foods and the country's culture by incorporating aboriginal art into projects, for example making a boomerang.

Art

Developing skills for painting and drawing (including colour mixing) through landscape pictures and recreating a Sidney Nolan painting.
Creating pictures inspired by Aboriginal (dot) art and looking at textures in our art work.

Geography

Using maps and atlases, we will be looking at where Australia is in the world, its physical and human features, its weather and its culture and comparing this to the four nations of the UK.
