

## English

Hear your child read on a daily basis and practise reading and spelling the tricky words.

Read traditional tales and other books with your child and talk about them. Can your child tell you the main events and order of the story? Can they predict what might happen?

Encourage your child to write for different purposes: lists, postcards and birthday cards.

## Mathematics

Talk about how much things cost when you go shopping and let them handle the money with you.  
Discuss how long it will take to do something- time them doing a physical activity, can they beat their last time?  
Look at the packaging of drinks and food for weights and volume.  
Follow a recipe and let your child cook with you, helping to measure out ingredients.  
When eating and cutting food, practise cutting in halves and quarters and sharing sweets evenly between family.

## Science

### Habitats

Go for a walk or visit a pond and look at the nature around you. What are the animal and plant names and how do these animals and plants live together? What do they eat?

## Optional ways to help your child

### PSHE

Talk to your children about comfortable and uncomfortable feelings including problems with friendships and how they can deal with them through seeking help and support from an adult.

### R.E

Visit different religious buildings and talk to the religious leaders.

Introduce the term faith and allow children to share their own values and beliefs and discuss why it is important to respect beliefs of other people.

## Music

Listen to a wide range of music with your child. Clap along to the rhythm. Ask if they like the music and why?

## P.E

Encourage your child to be as active as possible. Using hands when climbing and monkey bars helps with hand strength and therefore pencil control. Play throwing and catching games.
