

English

- Children will explore the genre of persuasion, writing and performing their own persuasive speeches.
- Through investigating poetry, the children will develop ways to up level the vocabulary they choose to use in their written work.
- They will also learn about the features of a play script, using The Jungle Book as a focus, before creating their own scripts.
- Additionally, the children will explore formal and informal language and apply this understanding through letter writing.
- Class Reader: Orchard Greek Myths by Geraldine McCaughrean.

Mathematics

- Number and Place Value moving beyond 3 digit numbers.
- Addition and Subtraction; Multiplication and Division, including money amounts and remainders.
- Fractions, including equivalent fractions and linking with division.
- Measurement, including time intervals, reading roman numerals,
- Geometry: Position & Direction; properties of 3D shapes, polygons and triangles. Statistics, including bar charts and pictograms.

Problem Solving Strategies: Logical Reasoning and Draw a table

Science

Forces and magnets

Children will observe that magnetic forces can act without direct contact, unlike most forces, where direct contact is necessary. They will also explore the behaviour and everyday uses of different magnets.

Circuits and components

Children will construct simple circuits, trying different components, for example, bulbs, buzzers and motor, and switches. They will learn about precautions for working safely with electricity.

Computing

Children will be creating branching databases and using graphing programs to sort information. They will understand the importance of computer simulations to solve problems.

PSHE

Our PSHE learning will focus on the following themes:

R.E

Children will be investigating religious rules and how they influence actions, making links to the Islamic religion. They will also explore why Zakat is important to Muslims and why is the Qur'an sacred and how is it looked after.

Music

Children will be exploring the 'disco' musical genre using instruments to create an exciting ensemble.

P.E

Children will have P.E on a Tuesday and Wednesday. Throughout the term, children will be increasing their skills through a range of athletics games and exploring outdoor and adventurous activities.

History

The children will be studying Ancient Greece in order to develop an understanding of Greek life. They will explore the achievements made in this era and the influence of the Ancient Greeks on the western world. They will learn about democracy, works of art, including archaeology and mythology.

Art and Design

Children will improve their mastery of art and design techniques through clay sculpture, creating and designing Ancient Greek style pottery.

Design and Technology

The children will explore how shoes are constructed, before designing and making their own sandal in the style of the Ancient Greeks.

Languages
