

## English

Continue reading a range of texts with and to your child, on a daily basis talking about what has been read. Children will earn a House Point each time they read at home and an adult signs their reading record.

Read, perform and discuss some play scripts written for children, perhaps moving on to writing a play script of their own.

Research age appropriate non-fiction texts, including newspapers.

Continue practising and applying spellings from previous weeks.

## Mathematics

Continue practising multiplication tables with your child. Also, board and card games are helpful to aid/maintain fluency with small numbers.

Practice telling the time with your children throughout the day using both digital, analogue and Roman numeral clocks.

Please take any opportunity to discuss bus or train timetables to calculate intervals of time.

## Science

Our topic for this term is Life Cycles.

Perhaps your children would like to grow some plants at home.

Watch documentaries together.

## PSHE

**As transition to secondary school approaches, encourage your child to talk about what we have been thinking about in school.**

## R.E

**Our focus is on Creation Stories from various religions. Your child might like to find out about these at home.**

## Music

Get your child to identify the different technological musical compositions around them and the purpose of these pieces of music, such as within adverts, ringtones, jingles etc.

## P.E

Encourage your child to be as active as possible. Children should be aiming to be active for 1 hours a day, but only 30 minutes of this is provided within school.

## Geography

Encourage both paper and electronic map reading skills and explore using Google Earth.

## Computing

Continue to discuss internet safety. Access Purple Mash.
